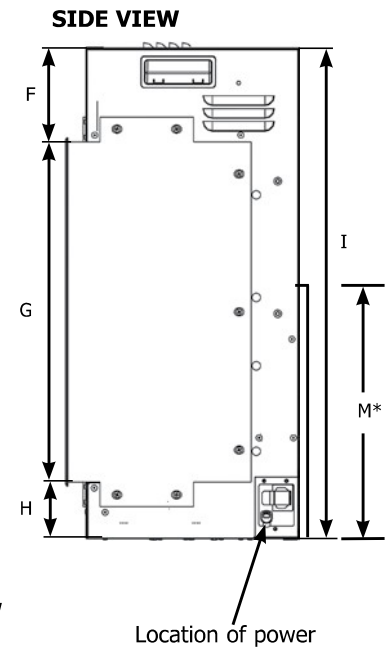
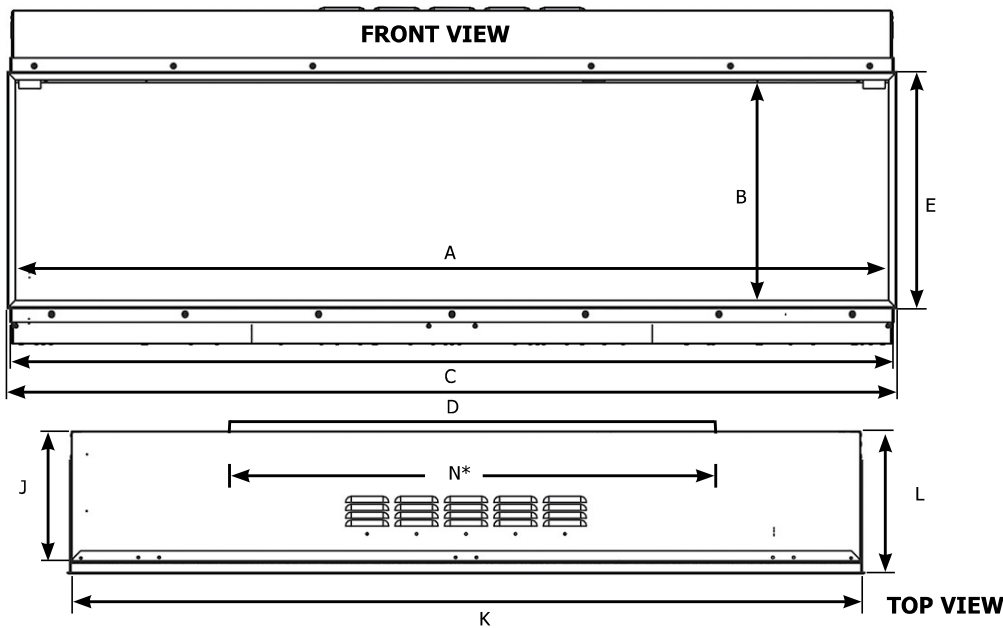

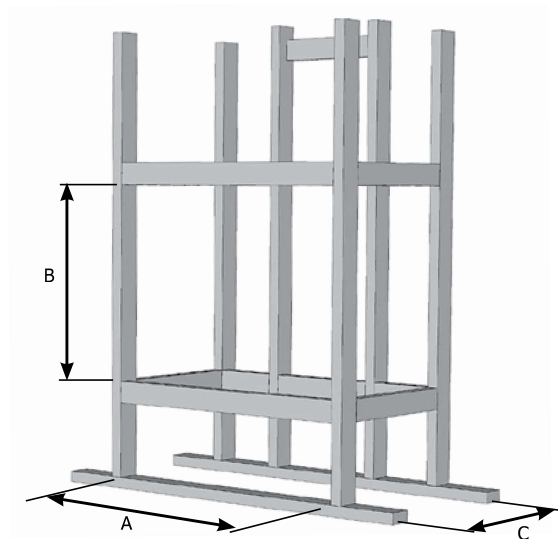

Framing/Finishing Instructions

FRONT VIEWING FACE INSTALLATION (SINGLE SIDED)

NOTE: Framing may be constructed of combustible material (i.e. 2 x 4/2 x 6) and does not require steel studs.



NOTE: The appliance must be installed on a flat, solid, continuous surface (e.g. wood, metal, concrete), which must be the full width and depth of appliance.

This may be the floor, or raised up on a platform to enhance its visual impact.

Note: Measurement (B) does not include height of platform base if raised off the ground.

Example 1/2"(13 mm) thick platform base = 23-3/4" (603 mm) framing height.

Framing/Finishing Instructions

COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (SINGLE SIDED)

Note: Ensure that The nailing flanges are adjusted based on the overall depth of finishing material being used as shown in the nailing flange section of this manual. Maximum finishing material thickness is 7/8" (22 mm) when using the supplied decorative finishing trim.

The appliance is designed to be used with standard wall sheathing materials such as drywall, plywood, wood composites, or non-combustible materials with the supplied decorative trim. Thicker materials may also be used.

Thicker finishing materials would need to go around the perimeter of the decorative finishing trim. Ensure there is a minimum of 1/16" (3 mm) gap around the perimeter of the decorative trim to ensure safe removal to clean glass or for servicing appliance.

See technical specifications in this manual for overall sizes of decorative trim.

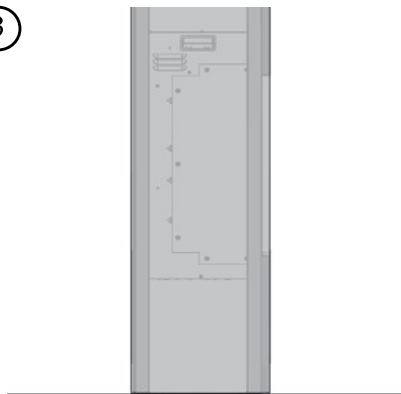
Facing and/or finishing materials must never overhang into the glass opening.

Facing materials may be combustible or non-combustible.

To cover cut/ exposed edges of the combustible facing material or any other finishing materials being used we suggest using J Style Trim or Metal Corner Bead purchased at your local hardware store.

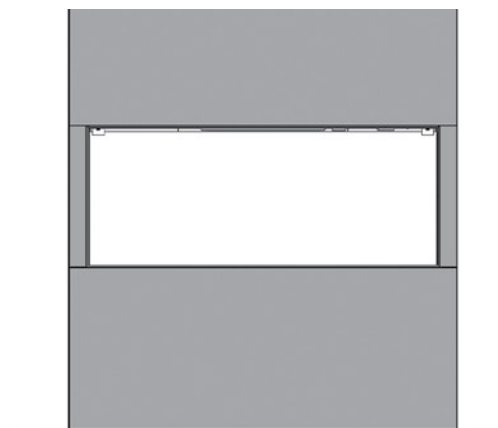

TWO SIDED VIEW INSTALLATION (LEFT/RIGHT SIDED)

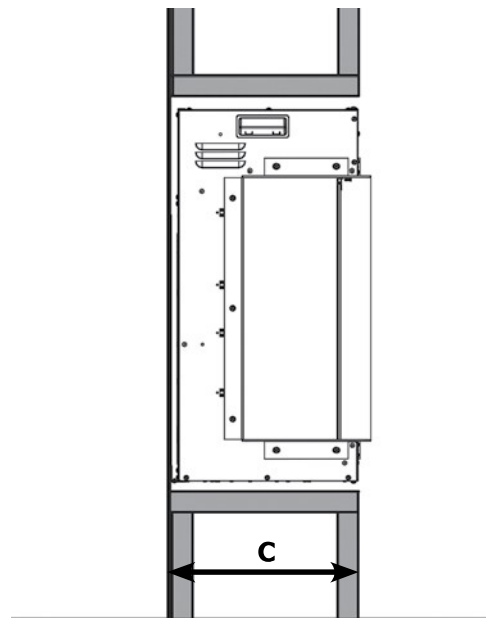
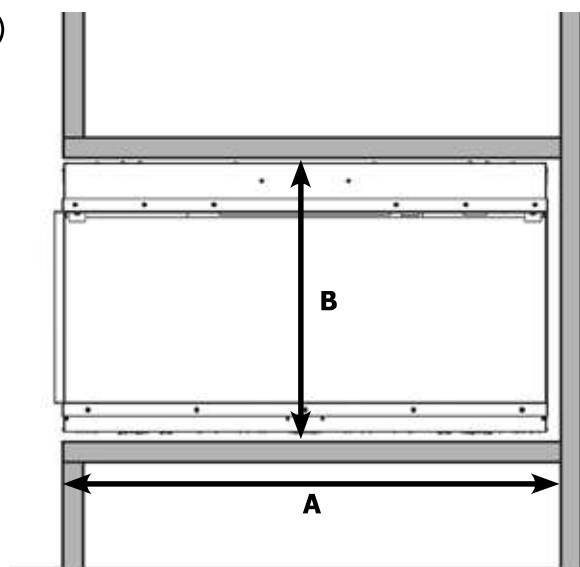
Note: If glass is going to be on other side, simply reverse framing methods. Framing shown with small glass on left hand side.

NOTE: The appliance must be installed on a flat, solid, continuous surface (e.g. wood, metal, concrete) which must be the full width and depth of appliance.

This may be the floor, or raised up on a platform to enhance its visual impact.

Note: Measurement (B) does not include height of platform base if raised off the ground.

Example 1/2"(13 mm) thick platform base = 25-3/4" (654 mm) framing height.

Note: Ensure that The nailing flanges are adjusted based on the overall depth of finishing material being used as shown in the nailing flange section of this manual. Maximum finishing material thickness is 7/8" (22 mm).

The appliance is designed to be used with standard wall sheathing materials such as drywall, plywood, wood composites, or non-combustible materials.

Thicker materials may also be used.

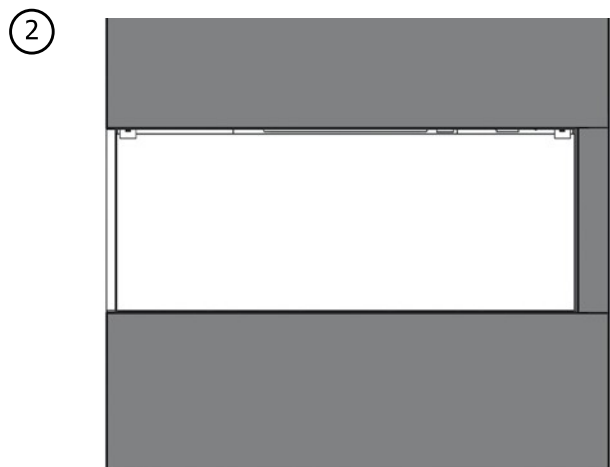
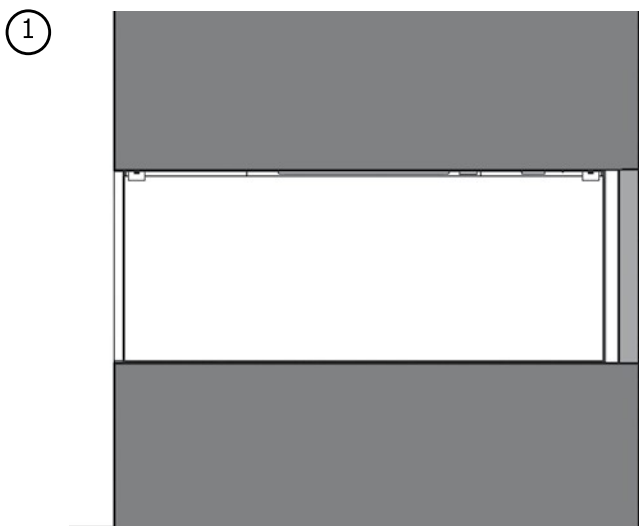
Note: The decorative finishing trim is not used when installed as as a two sided view and will need to be recycled.

Facing and/or finishing materials must never overhang into the glass opening.

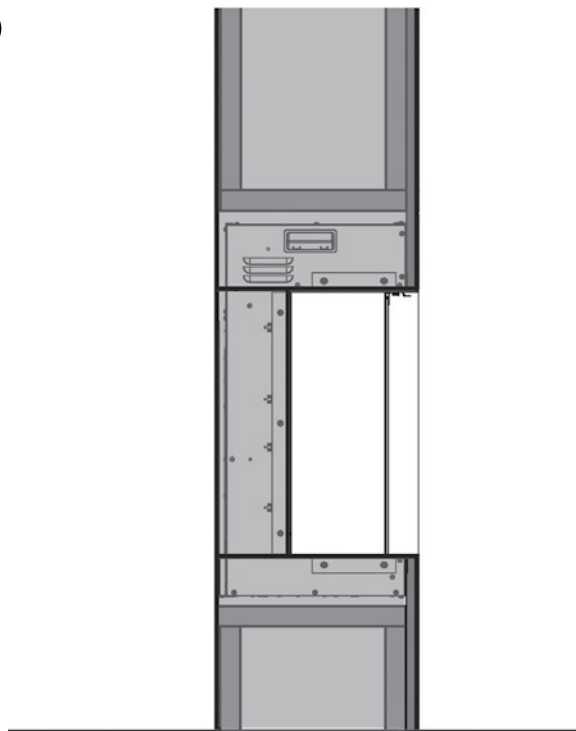
